4.1.1 Availability of adequate infrastructure and physical facilities viz., classrooms, laboratories, ICT facilities, cultural activities, gymnasium, yoga centre etc. in the institution.

Response

Our college has ample physical infrastructural facilities such as classrooms, laboratories, seminar halls, library, computers, and other academic resources to support the Teaching Learning Process. The college campus has spread over an area of 9.31 acres. The large H-shaped four storied building is the main space for all curricular and co-curricular activities of the College.

There are 56 furnished class rooms of which 31 are ICT-enabled with projector facility. Class rooms are adequately furnished with white/black boards. Natural Science laboratories have provision for converting ICT-enabled class rooms. The rooms are well ventilated and in accordance with the requirement of the program for which it is intended. Five well equipped Computer Science laboratories catering to the academic requirement of computer science students. Laboratory facilities are provided to all physical and natural science subjects along with Humanity subjects like Psychology and Journalism.

These labs are utilized for conducting practical classes as per the requirements of the curriculum. Language department is equipped with Multi-media Language laboratory with a seating capacity for 20 persons. There are 8 audio visual halls each with 100 seating capacity in the main building and 2 audio visual halls in Library building ; one having 250 seating capacity and another with 75 seating capacity.

The institution has adequate facilities for cultural activities, sports, games, indoor, outdoor, gymnasium, yoga centre etc.

Our college strives for overall personality development of our students by providing adequate infrastructural facilities to conduct co-curricular, extra-curricular, sports and games activities in the college. Optimum utilization of the infrastructure is ensured by the institution by allocating infrastructural space to every curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activity of the College and these activities form a part of the regular time table. A certificate course in Yoga is run in a spacious hall with relaxed ambience having fresh air and natural light.

Inter-college music and singing competition organized every year to commemorate Founders Day, inter class cultural competitions are conducted every year as a part of Annual Day Celebrations, Mangalore University level Inter-collegiate cultural competitions, Commerce Fest, Business Management fest are some of the regularly conducted extracurricular activities in the college.

The institution has fully automated library that uses KOHA ILMS. This programme has every step of the system charging and discharging procedure. Circulation of books is done with the help of a barcode system. The library has a total collection of 96000 books. There are 130 different sorts of journals and publications. And institution subscribes to 13 daily newspapers of which 6 are in kannada and other 7 are in English.

The college has provided spacious parking facility for staff and student. Water purifier is made available for drinking water to both staff and students. A Small water harvesting system is maintained in the campus for the enhancement of the

water level in the campus. IQAC Office, NCC ARMY and NAVY office, NSS office, Women forum, Rovers and Rangers, Red Cross, Career guidance cell etc. are provided with independent rooms for smooth functioning of academic co-curricular activities.

Following **auditoriums/halls and rooms are provided for the conduct of extracurricular activities such as drama, dance, skits, music, exhibitions, cultural festivals and competitions, awareness programmers, training programmers, etc.**

Adequate facilities are provided to conduct sports and games - both indoor and outdoor.

A spacious playground located within the college campus is used to conduct various sports activities.

The playground accommodates standard measured playing courts for Basketball, Volleyball, Throw ball, Tennikoit and Kabbadi.

Well laid out Cricket pitch is maintained to play hard ball cricket. A 200 meter oval shaped track facilitates various sprint events.

Besides these, there are separate standard measured pits for jumping and throwing events such as; High jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Javelin throw, Shot-put, Hammer throw, Discus throw, etc.

The college has an Indoor Games Complex with Shuttle Badminton courts, Carrom, Chess, Table-Tennis rooms. It also houses a sports library and two staff rooms.

A separate Indoor Sports Complex for ladies is constructed to provide separate space for girl students to practice sports and games.

The gymnasium of the college, where training facilities like multi-gym for body building and weight lifting are available.

The ladies' indoor sports complex also has a separate provision for this activity.

A separate wrestling ring for training the students in Greco-Roman style is available in the Indoor Sports and Games complex.

Indoor Sports and Games complex has two rooms for accommodation of visiting teams. Other basic facilities like water cooler, separate dressing rooms, rest rooms are available in the Indoor Games complex.

Policy of the institution towards acquisition, Utilization and maintainance of infrastructure.

The purchase policy is based on transparency and fairness and is need based. A Purchase committee shall be duly constituted for coordinating Purchase activities. The purchase committee shall finalize the purchase of an item by inviting quotations/tenders. The purchase of an item is generally based on the lowest rate quoted provided it meets the required standards. Building committee of the College is in charge of purchase of building materials for construction activities.

There are adequate laboratory assistants in the Science Departments viz. Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, and Bio-science laboratories to maintain the equipment and laboratories. The Department Head shall be responsible for maintenance and utilization of the labs and appropriate guidelines shall be given to the users. The stock in the labs are verified annually, and damaged ones are discarded. Electrical and Electronic equipment are checked regularly at the end of the academic year.

Computer maintenance:

It is ensured to have computer rooms dust free and properly cleaned from time to time. The computers available in Administrative offices, Departments and Laboratories shall be maintained through dedicated I.T staff of the college.

Classrooms:

The classroom facilities such as whiteboards, blackboards, electrical fittings and furniture, etc. are regularly cleaned and maintained. A separate shed is in place in the campus to repair the broken furniture's and carpenters are hired to repair them. The departments will be given the charge of classrooms coming under their purviews. The Head of the Department and Class Teachers ensure cleanliness is maintained in the class rooms and surroundings.

Library

The Librarian, and the team of support staff, shall look after the maintenance of the library books, journals, periodicals, furniture, electronic equipment, computers and software. Pest Management measures shall be periodically carried out in the library. Efforts shall be taken to preserve the books and journals, dust free.

College Ground:

The Physical Education Department is entrusted with the proper maintenance of ground and gymnasium. Necessary instructions are given by the Physical Director to the students as to how to use the ground, basketball court, gymnasium equipment etc. Girl sportspersons are given instructions in this regard by a female Assistant Physical Director.

Parking:

Adequate parking facilities for bicycles, motorized two wheelers and four wheelers are available at two locations. Proper directions are given to staff and students as to where they can park their vehicles.

Electrical and Water facilities: The College Estate officer is in charge of the maintenance of the physical infrastructural facilities. There are housekeeping staff members and the college has also made arrangements with electricians and plumbers who are employed by the college to perform necessary repair and installation works. The Estate Manager will coordinate the repairs and maintenance works. The generators shall be properly maintained by the housekeeping staff. The garden and other facilities are maintained with the help of expert gardener by outsourcing. Timely watering of plants is ensured. The rain water harvesting facilities is supervised by the College Estate Manager.

Security;

Security personnel are deployed in the college and hostel. Night security personnel are also deployed. CCTV is installed in all the prime locations of the Campus and also at every corner of the college corridor. A monitoring room is also provided to view the c.c.camera footage in real time. It is also ensured that proper safety measures such as fire extinguishers are maintained.
